# Principal's Message

Everything is on track to return from our virtual pause on **Thursday, May 6<sup>th</sup>.** Until that time, students should continue to participate in Google Classroom and Zooms according to the schedule. Please encourage students to stay caught up on their assignments and activities during the virtual period as teachers are taking attendance and grading assignments. It's important students avoid digging themselves any kind of hole so close to the end of the year. Teachers are offering extending support during the final half of Zoom sessions for any students who need help or have questions. It is likely they can receive one-on-one help in most situations at that time. If students need additional support, they should contact teachers by email or calling the school.

### **PSAT Testing – Final Make-Ups**

About 90-95% of our students have now completed the PSAT testing for both 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade. We still have a few that were in quarantine or absent during both the initial testing and the make-up testing last week. We will attempt to test these students on May 6<sup>th</sup> and May 7<sup>th</sup> when they return from the virtual pause.



### 8<sup>th</sup> Grade M-STEP Testing – May 12<sup>th</sup> – (Late Start for 9<sup>th</sup> Grade)

Due to the virtual pause, we needed to push back 8<sup>th</sup> Grade M-STEP testing for Social Studies and Science to **Wednesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>.** Each test takes about an hour and is taken on the computer. Students should be very familiar with the format of this test as they have been taking M-STEP for the past several years.

Because 9<sup>th</sup> grade students DO NOT TAKE THE M-STEP, they will have a ½ Day of School (do not report until 11:00am) on <u>Wednesday, May 12<sup>th</sup></u>. This allows us to maximize our computers and resources to test ALL 8<sup>th</sup> grade students in one morning without having to do a crazy schedule. All 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will be provided with transportation to school on Wednesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>. The buses will just be coming <u>approximately 4 hours later</u> than their normal pick-up time. Students will be served lunch when they arrive during their normal lunch schedule.



### **Returning Chromebooks**

Our plan is to allow students who checked out Chromebooks to keep them as long as possible. These are useful even during face-to-face instruction because most students will use theirs during regular class periods. What that being said, we

will most likely start collecting them at the beginning of June to ensure we have all of them before the end of the year. Please make sure all Chromebooks are returned with the charger that was given to you at the time of checkout.



PAC Meetings (Parent Advisory Council)

Each month we hold a PAC meeting at Zemmer. The PAC is different than a PTC in that we focus on academics and other matters that are directly related to the school day, rather than fundraisers or other events.

### **Academic Awards for Zemmer Students**

Traditionally every September we hold an Academic Award Ceremony at the LHS auditorium to honor our students from the previous year. Students who receive at least a 3.5 grade point average the prior year earn a reward. For first time award winners in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade, students receive a junior varsity letter. With each subsequent year, students receive a pin to put on that JV letter. Students who earn the reward as 9<sup>th</sup> graders receive a varsity letter.



This year, due to Covid-19 restrictions, we were not allowed to gather an audience in the auditorium. We pushed off handing out rewards in the hope that restrictions may be lifted to allow for a ceremony. Unfortunately, that never happened. Therefore, principals will be passing out JV letters and pins at school to students in their classrooms to show our recognition in front of their peers. All current 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students who earned a 3.5 grade point average **last year** should receive their award in the coming weeks. # **Spring Sports Season**

Our Middle School Spring Sports are under way! Baseball, Softball, and Track are all running as scheduled and have started competitions. COVID guidelines and regulations are listed below as well as game schedules. Please check in at lapeerlightning.com regularly for updates to practice schedules, up to date information, and game scores. Come out this season and support our Spring athletes!

### COVID 19 Guidelines for middle school athletic events:

The following COVID 19-related accommodations are in place for all Middle School Spring Sports competitions:

- There will be no concessions available per MHSAA guidelines, however, spectators are permitted to bring their own capped (water, Gatorade, pop, etc.) beverages.
- Coaches and spectators must wear a mask at all times. Spectators must also practice social distancing to the extent possible.
- Baseball, Softball, and Track athletes, when in active participation, do not need to wear masks. They will however be required to wear masks when in the dugouts, bleachers, waiting for events to start, before and after games, etc.
- All players must provide their own water.
- We will be charging \$3 at the gate for track meets. Baseball and Softball will not be charging at the gate.
- All spectators for all events must sign in upon arrival for the purpose of contact tracing.

- We will be monitoring the number of spectators at our events to make sure we are staying below the 20% capacity limit, however, we do expect to be able to accommodate everybody that wants to come and watch our Middle School Baseball, Softball, and Track events.
- All Spring athletes will be tested for COVID once per week throughout the season. Tentatively, we will be testing all 8<sup>th</sup> grade athletes on Wednesday of each week, right after school in the Zemmer Cafeteria.
- Athletes will be getting COVID testing release forms on the first day of practice/tryouts and those must be turned in to the Zemmer office by Monday, April 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Athletes will also have their temperatures checked and will be screened for COVID symptoms before every practice and competition.
