Parents & Guardians:

As School Resource Officer at Zemmer Campus, it has been my top priority to address the safety and security of our school. While addressing multiple issues, I observed students were arriving and entering the building as early as 6:15 a.m. This poses a major health and safety issue as the building is not adequately staffed to monitor students in the case of an emergency until 7:00 a.m. Early entry before school personnel are on campus does not allow for monitoring of who enters the building.

In order to accommodate our early arrivers, the outside doors on the south side of the building will be open at 6:15 a.m. to allow shelter from the weather. Inside doors will be locked and students will not be able to enter the main building until 7:00 a.m. **Effective April 2, 2018 entry into Zemmer Campus will not be allowed prior to 7:00 a.m.** unless otherwise authorized by Administration for a school sanctioned activity or event.

It is understood that this will create issues with morning routines but again, student safety is our top priority. You are receiving this message in advance to allow time for adjustments to your morning routines, and we encourage you to make these adjustments prior to Spring Break if possible.
