The building opens at 7am. After school, students should leave the building by 2:30pm unless involved in a supervised activity or class. The Media Center and the cafeteria are open until 3:25pm for students who need space to work, or are waiting for athletic practices to start.

School Pictures/IDs

Because we are virtual until October 5th at the earliest, the School Picture Retake day that was set for September 25th has been postponed. This will be rescheduled at a later date when there is a clearer picture of the long-term instructional plan.

Principal's Message

As you are aware, since the last newsletter, there have been a few changes to the beginning of the year schedule. The main changes are:

The start date has been pushed back until September 8th.

- On September 8th through September 11th, students will be attending school in-person one day, in limited capacity. Please see the full schedule below.
- All instruction will be online until October 5th. Please stay tuned for new information as it becomes available on the plan to transition to in-person instruction.
- For the week of September 8th through September 11th, all teachers will have their Google Classrooms active. Please see the codes for these classes at the end of this newsletter. The lessons for the 8th-11th will be much more limited than when full virtual instruction begins on September 14th.

On-Boarding Week

To help prepare students for the interim virtual instruction, and to give them a chance to meet their teachers and follow their schedule, we are dedicating September 8th through 11th as "On-Boarding Week". There will only be roughly 25% of the students in the school each day. Please see the schedule below.

Here's a breakdown of what that week will look like:

- Zemmer will be open during normal school hours
- Students will receive virtual learning information, procedures, expectations, course materials, access to technology, logins, etc.
- Students will have the opportunity to establish a relationship with their teacher
- Students will complete coursework in Google Classroom each day (no Zoom sessions in first week) to the best of their ability. We understand many students will not yet have access to Chromebooks.
- Transportation and food service will be provided as normal

Washington D.C. Trip

At press time, the district is working on a communication for all Washington D.C. students and parents. We expect this communication to go out by the end of this week or early next week. It will contain any changes or adjustments that will be made (if applicable) to students who are attending.

First Day of School (Week of September 8th-11th)

On the day of On-Boarding week that students attend “in-person”, they should bring their schedules. We also recommend students snap a picture of their schedule on their phone so they have a digital copy as well. Counselors will be available to help students who did not attend registration to make sure they have a schedule. Any student who does not know their schedule should seek out the counselor table near the front main entrance when arriving on their “in-person” day. **Schedules are active in PowerSchool currently.** This means that any student/parent should be able to get in PowerSchool and see a student’s daily schedule. Safety Precautions for On-Boarding Week

Just a reminder that all students **must have a facial covering** that is worn correctly at all times while school is in session. Exemptions from this would include:

- If they are outdoors and socially distanced.
- If they are eating in the cafeteria.
- If they have a medical exemption that has been turned into the office in advance of their arrival.

All LCS buildings will be following all the safety protocols that were communicated earlier this summer as well.

Virtual Instruction (Sept. 14th through October 5th)

Google Classroom: Every teacher will utilize Google Classroom to facilitate online instruction.

Students can begin signing up for these classes anytime. Please see the document at the end of this newsletter that lists ALL the Google Classroom Codes for each teacher. It is important to note that students must sign up for the correct section/hour.

Every Friday by 4:00pm, the teacher will post next week’s learning targets and assignments within Google Classroom. The student should work to complete these assignments throughout the week. Every day will have a new assignment that will be accompanied by the digital resources necessary to complete the assignments.

Zooms: Zoom Meetings are utilized to offer additional instruction and support to students on top of the assignments that are posted in Google Classroom. Some specifics on Zooms include:

- The purpose is to provide mini-lessons, clarification on assignments, extra support, and enrichment activities.
- Students will be expected to attend Zooms and follow their normal daily schedule on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays to the best of their ability. We understand this is difficult for some families who lack quality technology and WiFi to support video conferencing.
- Teachers will not be “teaching” the entire hour, but will be available to students who are in need of assistance or need to ask questions.

Student Email Account Password Change

All passwords for the "@students.lapeerschools.org" email accounts will be changed at 8pm on Sunday, September 6th to "Lightning#####" with the last 5 digits being the student number.

The reason for this is we anticipate many students will have forgotten their passwords to enter their accounts over the summer. Students can continue to use their current password until that time. Once students login, they will be prompted to change their password to anything they want. They should definitely write this password down in a safe place so they don't forget it.

Screening Tool

The health department and the CDC (Center for Disease Control) does not currently recommend universal symptom screenings (screening all students grades PreK-12) to be conducted by schools due to the time and interruption to the education process. Parents or caregivers should be strongly encouraged to monitor their children for signs of infectious illness every day prior to sending students to school. Therefore, parents and caregivers should screen your students daily before arrival to school. Please go to the following link for more details on how to properly screen students.

Bring Your Own Device

We are encouraging students to bring their own device during On-Boarding week on their "in-person" day (September 8th-11th). Teachers will be preparing students for virtual instruction, and we will have limited technology devices available to use because a large portion of them are being checked out to families. Our goal is to have 100% of students signed up and into their Google Classrooms by September 11th. The more students we have who can bring their own device next week the better as it will free up the limited devices we do have. Students that have smart phones can use them to sign up for Google Classroom. Students should download the Google Classroom App prior to their "in-person" day, and make sure they can sign in. Lack of Technology? Chromebook Checkout

At registration last week, we had a table set up for families who need to checkout a Chromebook. In two days, we had roughly 220 students sign-up to borrow a Chromebook. If you were unable to attend registration, you can still check out a Chromebook by contacting Mr. Chittle our Dean of Students at jchittle@lapeerschools.org or by calling the school 667-2423 (extension 3405). All students who completed a Chromebook checkout form at registration **will receive their Chromebook in their 1st hour next week when they are in attendance for On-Boarding.** Students that are at the high school for first hour will get it 2nd hour when they return to Zemmer.

Lack of WiFi?

We understand the limited availability of quality internet for many of our families. Each building is determining the systems they can offer to allow students (while we continue to be in Phase 4) to access Wi-Fi and/or computer labs.

On September 14th through October 2nd, we are allowing Zemmer students to utilize our cafeteria and/or computer lab if they lack quality Wi-Fi to complete the online assignments and potentially participate in some Zooms. Please see below for specifics.

- This is available every day school is in session from Sept. 14 through Oct. 2nd.
- Students may attend from 9:00am to 11:30am **OR** 12:30pm to 3:00pm
- Parents must provide their own transportation
- Students should bring their own technology or use the Chromebook that was checked out
- **Parents must sign up in advance by contacting Mr. Chittle, the Dean of Students at 667-2413 (extension 3405) or jchittle@lapeerschools.org**
- Students may sign up for only one session a day, but can sign up multiple times per week. If demand is too high, we may need to limit the amount of times students attend per week.
- Students that display negative behaviors may not be allowed to return
- Students must be picked up promptly at the end of their session
- There will be staff to supervise, but academic support will be limited

9th Grade PSAT Testing

For all Zemmer 9th grade students PSAT testing will take place on October 15th. Because 8th grade students DO NOT TAKE THE PSAT in the fall, they will have a ½ Day of School (do not report until 11:00am) on Thursday, October 15th. This allows us to maximize our resources to test ALL 9th grade students in one morning without having to do some crazy schedule. All 8th grade students will be provided with transportation to school on Oct. 15th, the buses will just be arriving approximately 3 hours later than their normal pick-up time. Students can be dropped off any time after 11:00am on this date.

How can you prepare now?

- Please make sure not to schedule student appointments on **October 15th**
- Begin talking to your student about the PSAT

- Review the practice test at <https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/pdf/psat-8-9-practice-test-1.pdf> This can help students become familiar with the format of the test

Lunch Deliveries

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, we are temporarily suspending ALL LUNCH DELIVERIES to the schools. We are attempting to limit traffic in and out of the building and this will help with that.

Busing

Students are not allowed to ride home on buses with other students (even with a parent note). This has always been a rule at Zemmer but is even more important now that we need to be able to complete contact tracing in the event of positive Covid-19 cases. It also prevents students from hopping on other buses with their friends without confirming with their parents. Before we instituted this rule, we would get many upset parent phone calls that their child did not return home as expected. If you would like your child to go to another student's home, you will need to work out transportation with their parents.



PAC Meetings (Parent Advisory Council)

Each month we hold a PAC meeting at Zemmer. The PAC is different than a PTC in that we focus on academics and other matters that are directly related to the school day, rather than fundraisers or other events. Any parent is welcome to attend. As the year is starting in a virtual environment, our first PAC meeting will be held via Zoom on Wednesday, September 9th at 9:00am. Below is the invite.

Fall Sports

A handful of our fall athletic offerings at the high school and middle schools have been practicing and competing since August, yesterday with a new Executive Order from Governor Whitmer and a follow up communication from the MHSAA, all of our fall athletic teams can now practice and compete during the fall season. We are incredibly excited for our student-athletes. Please understand that this is still a rapidly changing, fluid situation. We will continue to keep our parents and student athletes as informed as we possibly can as we move through our Fall Season.

Sport Specific Updates:

Middle School Information:

- **Middle School Cross Country:** Will continue as is.
- **8th Grade Girls Basketball:** Can begin practicing indoors on Wednesday September 9th. Practice will be at Zemmer from 3:30-5pm. Athletes can stay after school in the cafeteria until practice begins. Games will be Mondays and Wednesday and will most likely begin the week of September 21st. Our official game schedule will be released on Tuesday September 8th.
- **8th Grade Football:** Will begin practice on Wednesday September 9th. Practice will be at Zemmer, behind the school, from 5-7:30pm. Games will be on Wednesdays. Our League will be meeting soon to determine the date of our first game. Our official game schedule will be released on Tuesday September 8th.
- **8th Grade Sideline Cheer** – Can begin practicing indoors on September 9th. Practice will still be held at Zemmer outdoors on Tuesday, September 8th. A practice schedule will be provided to athletes at that time for the remainder of the season.

8th Grade Fall Athletic Clearance Process:

The Athletic Clearance Process remains the same as it has been the last two years. 8th Grade Athletes should turn in all paperwork to Mrs. Tiffany in the Zemmer main office prior to the start of the first practices. The Zemmer main office is open from 7:00am to 3:30pm. Both student and parent will need to be present for the clearance process in order to be able to fill out all paperwork (unless paperwork is pre-filled out). 9th grade students should complete the clearance process at LHS if possible, however, we can take care of it at Zemmer if it is more convenient. When athletes complete the clearance process, they will receive a bracelet that they need to wear to practices in order to participate.

The following items are available in the Zemmer office or online at <http://lapeerlightning.com> and MUST be turned in prior to first practice/tryout:

- All athletes must have a completed **2020-2021 MHSAA Physical** (dated April 15, 2020 or after – must be new form or sign waiver when turning in.) or a complete **MHSAA Health Questionnaire** (<https://www.mhsaa.com/portals/0/Documents/health%20safety/healthquestionnaire.pdf>) along with a valid **2019-2020 MHSAA Physical** (dated April 15, 2019 or after)
- All athletes must have a completed **Emergency Card**
- All athletes must have a signed **Athletic Code of Conduct Card** (parent & student signatures required)

***Pay to Participate must be paid in full before any athlete may participate in a game/contest/meet. Information will be forthcoming regarding when parents may begin paying pay-to-participate fees.**

***Please see the Athletic Code of Conduct for information on 8th Grade Eligibility requirements (grades) needed last year and current.**
