Penny Wars!!



The Bark Code and Bark Bucks are a part of the new initiative here at Zemmer Middle School that promotes Positive Behavior Incentives and Support (PBIS). This program is a team based framework for creating and sustaining safe and effective schools.

We here at Zemmer Middle School are devoted to preventing problem behavior and developing positive social skills. School-wide PBIS increases the capacity of schools to educate all students utilizing research-based school-wide, classroom and individualized interventions.

Students can spend the Bark Bucks, which they earn from displaying the positive behaviors that are identified in the Bark Code. Items for purchase range from free admission to sporting events, school-wide acknowledgement over the morning announcements, to gift cards to local businesses.
